

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Rear Sway Bar End link Kit Part # 67.10.100 Part #67.10.120 No Revision (5/1/2021)

## WHO SHOULD INSTALL THIS PRODUCT?

Progress Technology products should only be installed by a qualified licensed mechanic experienced in the installation and removal of suspension components. Please read instructions from start to finish and verify the parts in the parts list before beginning installation.

## **Parts List**

Description	Quantity
M10 Link, Male w- Jam Nut	4
M10 Flange nut	2
M10 Center Connector	2

- 1. This installation is to be performed with the vehicle's suspension loaded in order not to pre-load the suspension. This can be achieved on a drive on lift or a pair of car ramps. This end-link kit can be used with OEM (Original Equipment) or aftermarket sway bars.
- 2. Remove the OEM end link assemblies.
- 3. Assemble the new H-D end-links per the illustration (See Figure A). Adjust the length of the end-links to match the length of the OEM (Original Equipment) end-links.
- 4. Install the new H-D end-links in the same position as the OEM end-links.
- 5. Tighten the four jam nuts until they are snug against the connectors. Use two open end wrenches.
  - 6. Torque the four M10 flange nuts to 42 ft/lbs. A 5mm hex wrench may be necessary hold the threaded stud while tightening until the nut is snug. Use a torque wrench and 41mm socket for the final tightening of the four flange nuts.


